

1. Login to www.noodletools.com. Your user name should be your computer user name. Your password should be your student ID number.
2. If you have not already done so, create a new project. *Create one project per assignment*. Choose MLA. Choose Advanced. Name it something you will remember (Cancer project, EII research paper, etc.).

3. Across the top, choose Sources. Click on “Add a Citation”.
